

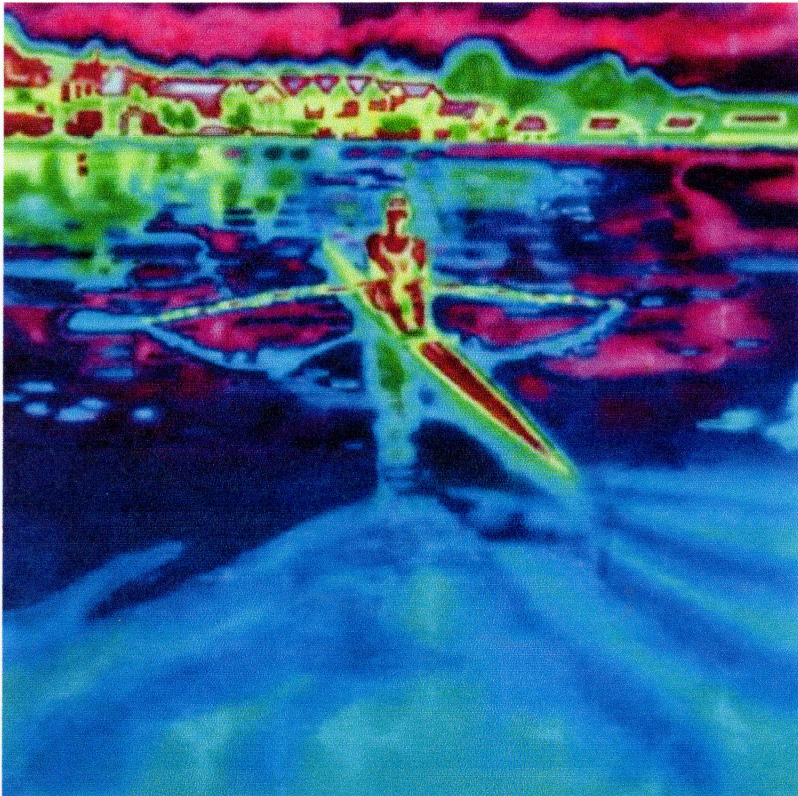
Artist uses Flir T425 thermal-imaging camera to show commitment of British elite athletes

T425 thermal-imaging camera

A Flir T425 thermal-imaging camera supplied by Bedford-based Thermascan has been used to provide artistic images of British elite athletes.

The camera — normally utilised for predictive maintenance and condition monitoring duties — has been used by Penny Crofts, an artist whose work was recently shown at the Expo Fine Art Gallery at Heathrow Terminal 5.

She discovered that thermography gave her an interesting way of expressing her interest in the human body. Crofts also found that thermal imaging was a good way to showcase her subjects' athletic commitment.
